



The short trip / 3 days

Day 1: The Golden Circle and Beyond

Morning

Pick up your campervan in Reykjavik and start your journey.

Head towards the Golden Circle, a 300 km loop that contains some of Iceland's most stunning sights.

First stop, Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site rich in history and geology.

Afternoon:

Visit the Geysir Geothermal Area and marvel at Strokkur, which erupts every few minutes.

Continue to Gullfoss, the iconic 'Golden Falls', and witness its magnificent water cascade.

Evening:

Drive to the Secret Lagoon at Fludir to relax in the natural hot springs.

Camp overnight in one of the nearby designated camping areas.

Day 2: South Coast Wonders

Morning:

Head to Seljalandsfoss Waterfall, where you can walk behind the waterfall's veil.

Continue to Skógafoss Waterfall, another breathtaking drop that is both taller and wider.

Afternoon:

Visit the Solheimasandur Plane Wreck for a surreal experience on black sand beaches.

Explore the charming village of Vik with its dramatic seaside cliffs and puffin colonies.

Evening:

Settle for the night at a campsite near Vik, enjoying the coastal views and sounds.



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Day 3: Ice and Fire

Morning:

Drive towards the glacier lagoon, Jökulsárlón. It's a longer drive, but the sights of icebergs floating in the lagoon are unforgettable.

Take a walk along Diamond Beach, where ice chunks from the lagoon wash up on the black sand, glistening like diamonds.

Afternoon:

On your way back to Reykjavik, stop at the Fjaðrárgljúfur canyon, a massive canyon with steep walls and winding waters.

Evening:

Return to Reykjavik to enjoy a nice dinner downtown, reflecting on the epic sights and experiences of your Icelandic adventure.

Return the campervan and spend a restful night in one of Reykjavik's accommodations.

Remember to book campsites in advance and check the opening times and availability of all attractions, especially if traveling in the off-season. Also, driving times can be longer than expected due to weather conditions, so always plan for some flexibility. Enjoy your Icelandic adventure!
